Welcome back to the final term of 2020! In reflection – what a whirlwind of a year 2020 has been!

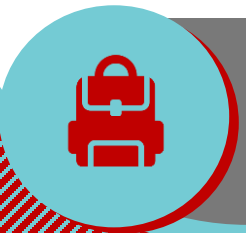

We will be delighted to have Anaru and family back with us - the Year 3-4 class will be ecstatic! Thankyou to you all for the SRC fundraiser – we will be depositing a healthy \$1,100 into Phil’s account to assist with rehabilitation. With only **9 weeks** ahead of us – we have a lot on the agenda! Some of the big events this term include:

- **BOOKWEEK** – Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Book Week which is typically held in Term 3 of every year (August) is scheduled for week 2 term 4 – Monday 19th of October through to Friday 23rd of October. There will be books on sale in our library during the week – make your way in to our amazing Book Fair. There will be some great Christmas gifts and stocking fillers on offer. The theme for Bookweek 2020 is “*Curious Creatures, Wild Minds*”. Dress up Day will be Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> of October – around the theme!
- **NAIDOC WEEK** was also postponed nationally during the peak of the pandemic, and is now scheduled for Week 5 Term 4 (8th-15th of November) with the theme being “Always was, Always will be”. Our school will celebrate with a range of cultural awareness raising activities to recognise our first nation people.
- **PUPIL FREE DAYS** – there are 2 consecutive Pupil Free Days scheduled for this term – Monday 23rd of November and Tuesday 24th of November. Staff will be travelling to Wudinna Area School to observe the 7 Steps to Writing Success and Brightpath strategies in action, both of which are being implemented in our site. This will provide the opportunity for our teaching staff to interact with the same year level teachers, exchange ideas and approaches that have proven successful with different year levels. The second day will be drafting our 2021 Improvement plan based on our 2020 data.
- **END OF YEAR EVENT** – this year we are going to do things a little differently. With the restrictions relating to indoor events/capacity of venues – we are hosting our end of year event outdoors at the school. This will be on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> of December – the night before the final day of term. More details will follow...it will be a night of spectacular dancing!

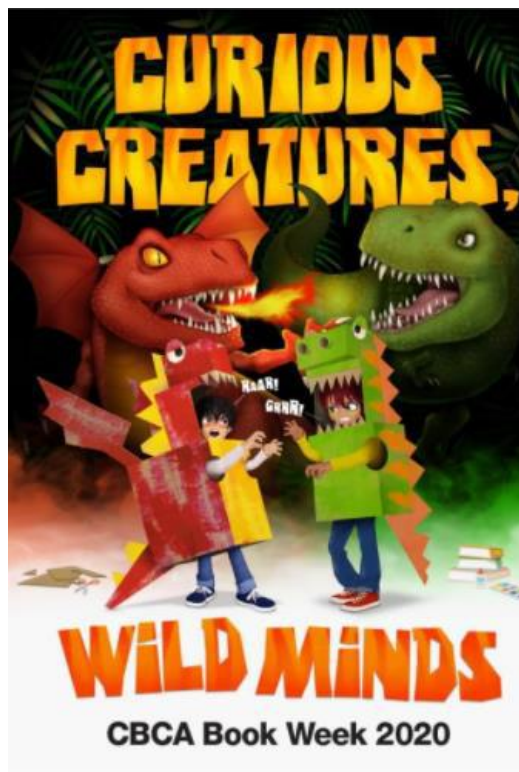
