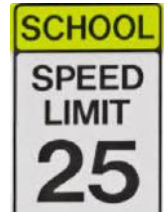

Important End of Term Reminders

***Student Reports:** The last day of this Term is next **Friday the 2nd of July**. There will be an end of term Assembly at 1.50pm and students will depart at **2.20pm**. Semester 1 Reports will be handed out to students before they leave. We encourage you to read through the report with your child and discuss the progress and areas for development for the following semester.

Years 1-7 student reports are based on an A-E achievement scale, supported by a description of what this means in relation to your child's progress against the achievement standard. Reports for Reception students use descriptive wording about students' progress over the year referenced to the Reception level achievement standard rather than A-E grades. If your child has a negotiated One Plan based on a verified need that outlines curriculum goals relating to another year level, he/she will be graded against that particular year level. This will be made clear in the report that your child will receive next week.

I will put out a table next week for people to look through and if they are not collected by the end of next week, they will be washed and put in our second hand uniform box.

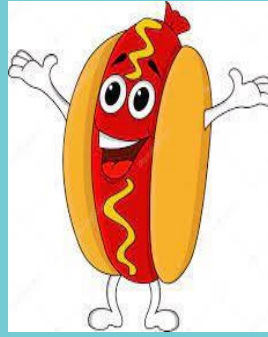
